

DSAC Northland Junior Race Series Point System

Trophies are awarded to only DSAC Club members (*at the end of the year banquet*) who participate in the Northland Junior Race Series. Overall series standing will be determined using the Continental Cup scoring formula: 1st place = 25 pts, 2nd place = 20 pts, 3rd place = 15 pts, 4th place = 12 pts, 5th place = 11 points, 6th place = 10 points, 7th place = 9 points, etc.....

A DSAC racer's finish at a NJRS race is his/her place relative to other DSAC racers on their age/sex group (e.g., a second place finish behind a non-DSAC racer counts as a first place finish, and thus earns the racer 25 points toward the overall series standings.)

Standings are determined by adding the most points earned from half plus rounded-up-one races held (including the championships). For example, for the nine races typically scheduled each year, the athletes' best five finishes will count. If only seven races are held (for instance, if there are cancellations), the best four finishes will count. ***This year we will only be having seven scored races, so the best four of seven will be used (half of seven, which is 3.5, plus rounded up one = four).***

Any DSAC racer finishing at least one fewer race (e.g. three, if seven are held) qualifies for a participation trophy in the overall series awards, but will not qualify for a first, second, or third place trophy.
